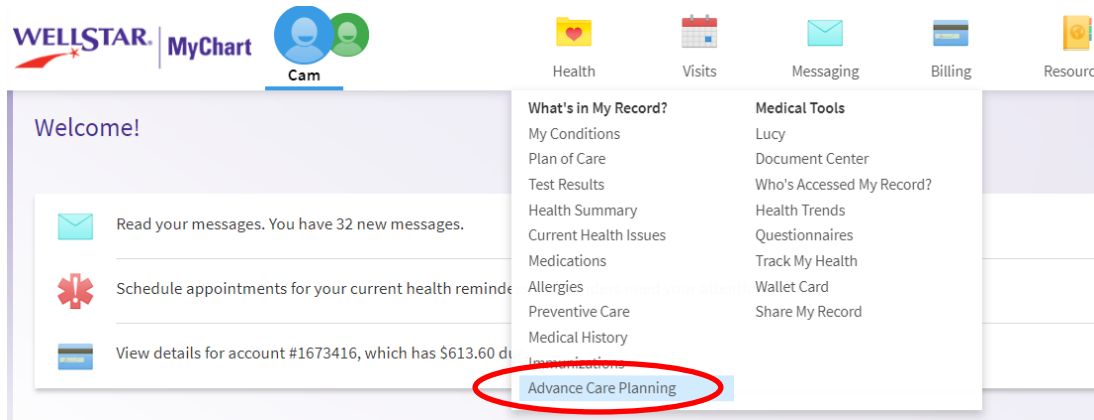


How Can I Update My Advanced Care Planning Information?

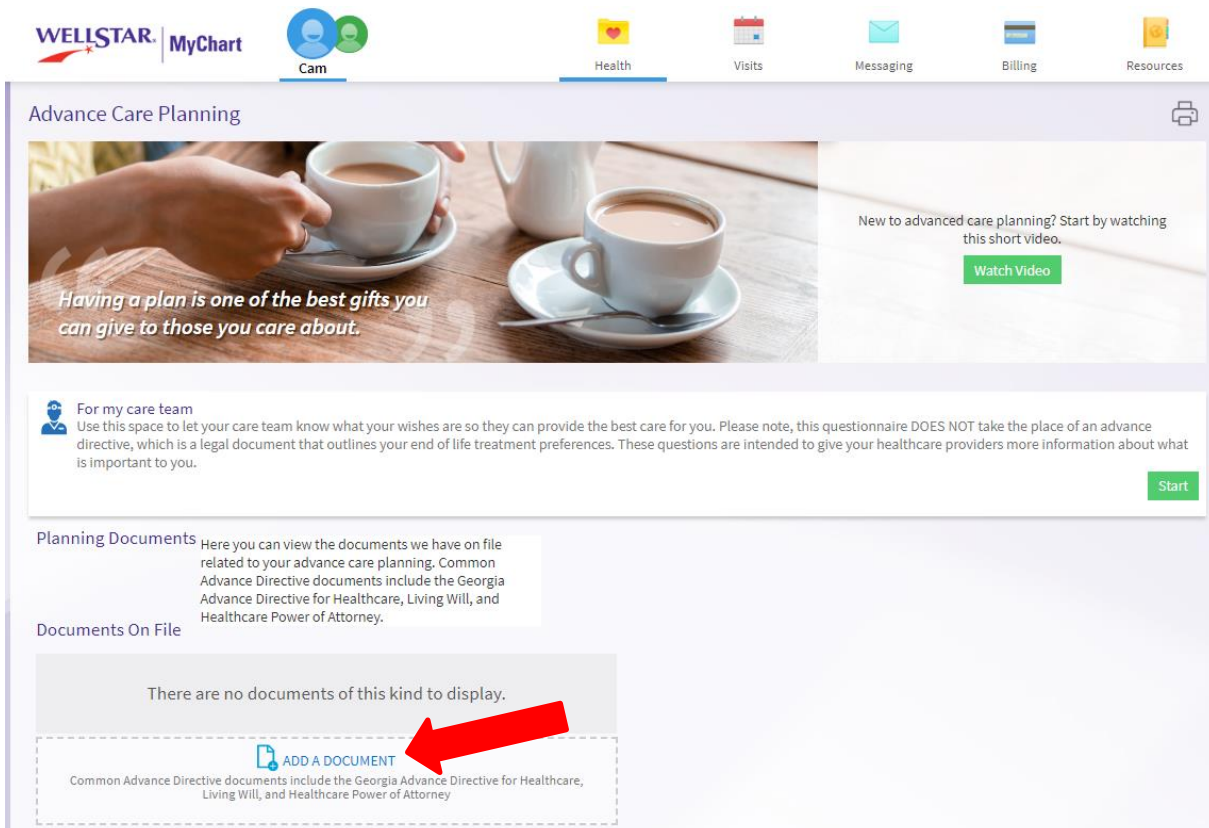
This tip sheet will review how to upload and document your advanced care planning information.

Try It Out

1. Log in to your MyChart account, under the “Health” menu select “Advanced Care Planning”



2. You can upload your documents for advanced care planning. Common Advanced Directive documents include; Georgia Advance Directive for Healthcare, Living Will and Healthcare Power of Attorney. To upload a document, select 'Add A Document'. **Please note:** only PDF file types are allowed for upload



- When you have selected the file you wish to upload, it will display under “Documents In Review” marked as ‘In Review’. Once you upload a document, you can click on the section to review it

Planning Documents Here you can view the documents we have on file related to your advance care planning. Common Advance Directive documents include the Georgia Advance Directive for Healthcare, Living Will, and Healthcare Power of Attorney.
